



Education is the engine of social mobility. The generation that has benefited from the funds delivered by Sapiencia represents a very positive intergenerational mobility for the city.

Wage increase after postgraduate studies




53.2% of the men and 62.2% of the women polled that work receive a salary between 1 and 4 current legal minimum monthly salaries.

In general, they consider that what has been studied contributes greatly to the role they play, especially those who accessed benefits from the **Advanced** training fund

Amid the beneficiaries there are better salary levels among those who carried out postgraduate degrees abroad.

Those who run their **own business** mostly manifest (83%) that postgraduate studies contribute greatly to their business development.

Perception about the benefit's contribution



95.1% of the polled women and **86.6** % of men stated that the benefit had improved their own quality of life and that of their families.

20.7% of people stated having mental health complications with their postgraduate studies.
