

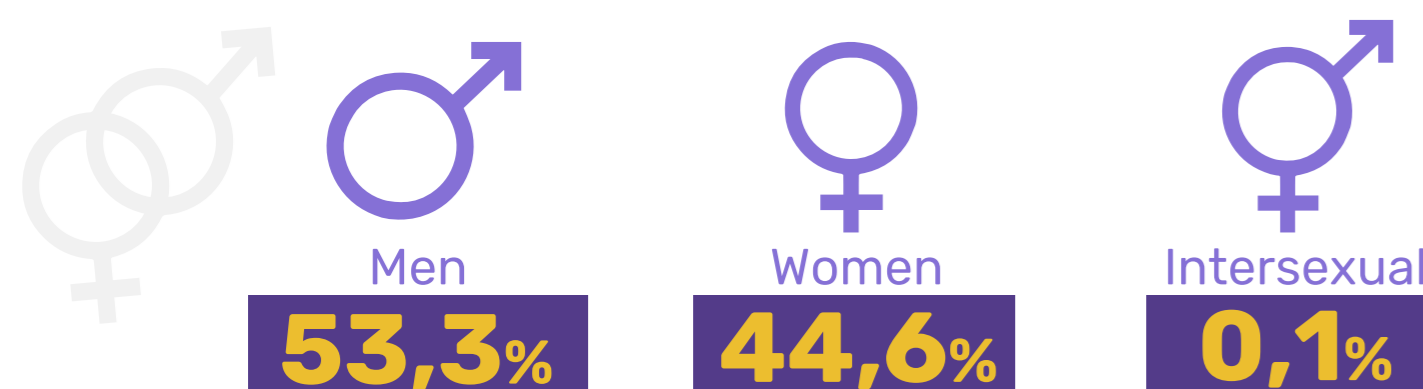

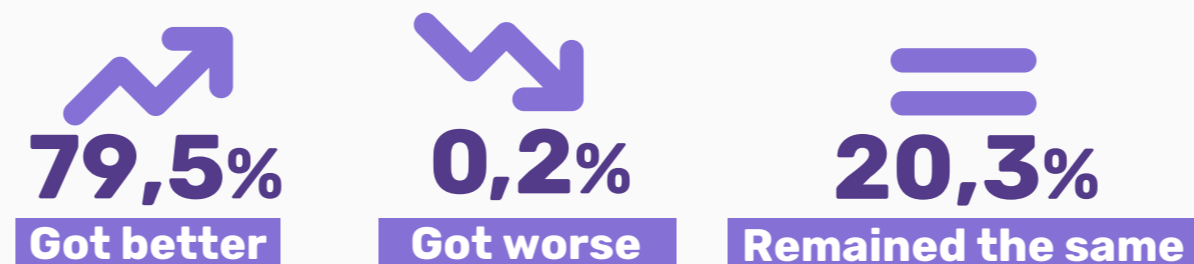


Through the following expressions, **the students express their satisfaction** with the Matrícula Cero benefit.

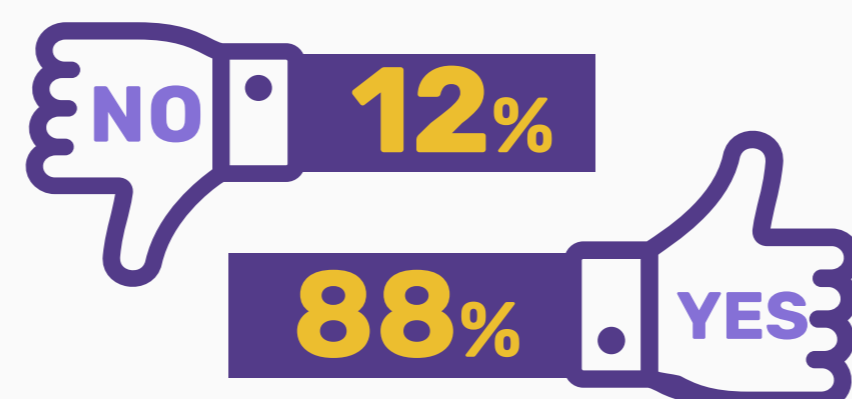
After receiving the benefit, how do you rate your academic performance?



97.6% of people say that Matrícula Cero creates the challenge of improving their academic performance.



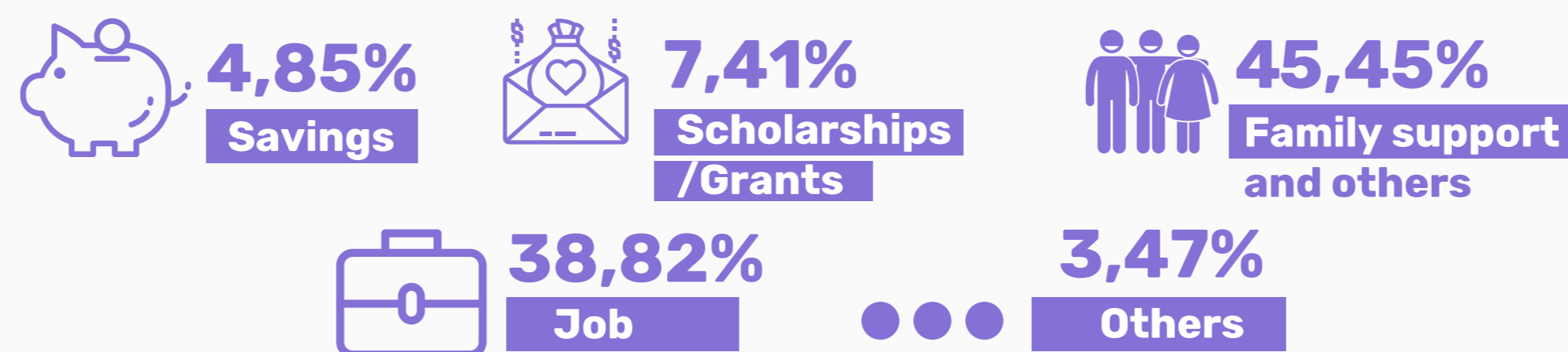
Has Matrícula Cero contributed to your full dedication to study?

What is the main source of support to assume the expenses associated with the academic process?

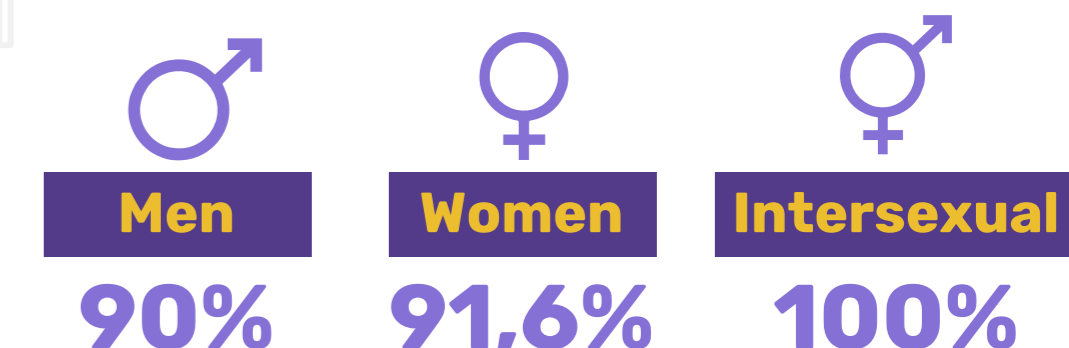

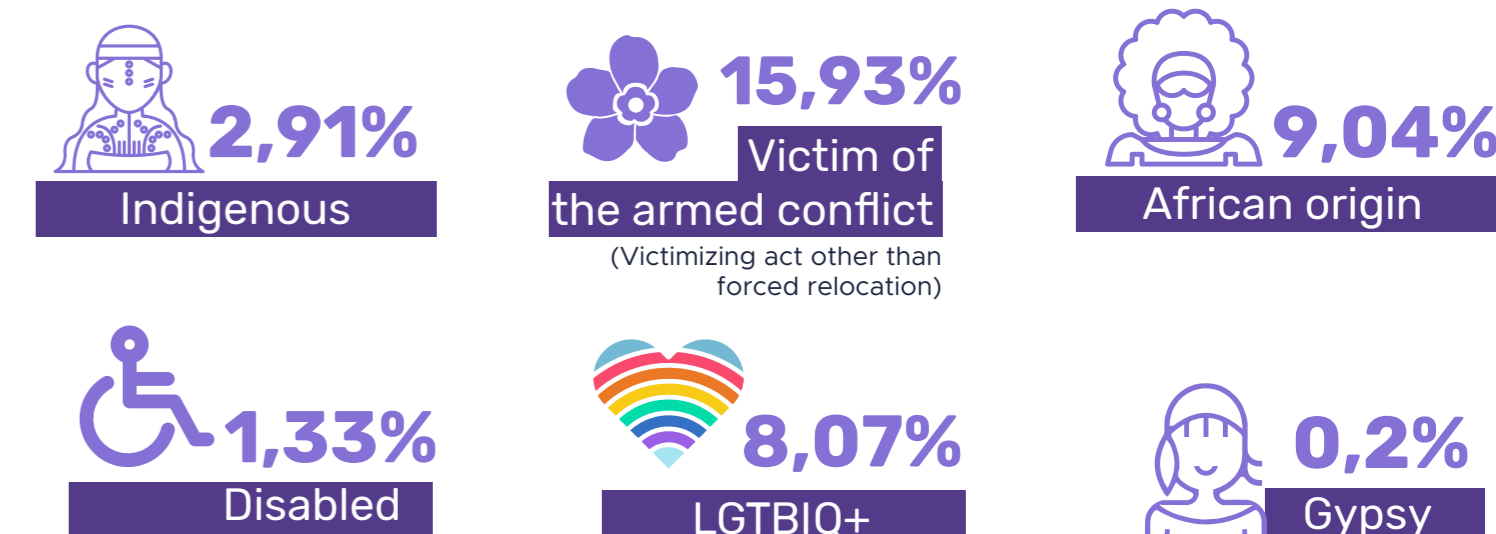


Before receiving the benefit had difficulties studying:
