


From the Observatorio de Sapiencia we wonder about the perception that


Through the following expressions, **the students** express their satisfaction with the Matricula Cero benefit.




97.6% of people say that Matrícula Cero creates the challenge of improving their academic performance.


Contribution to access and permanence in higher education
