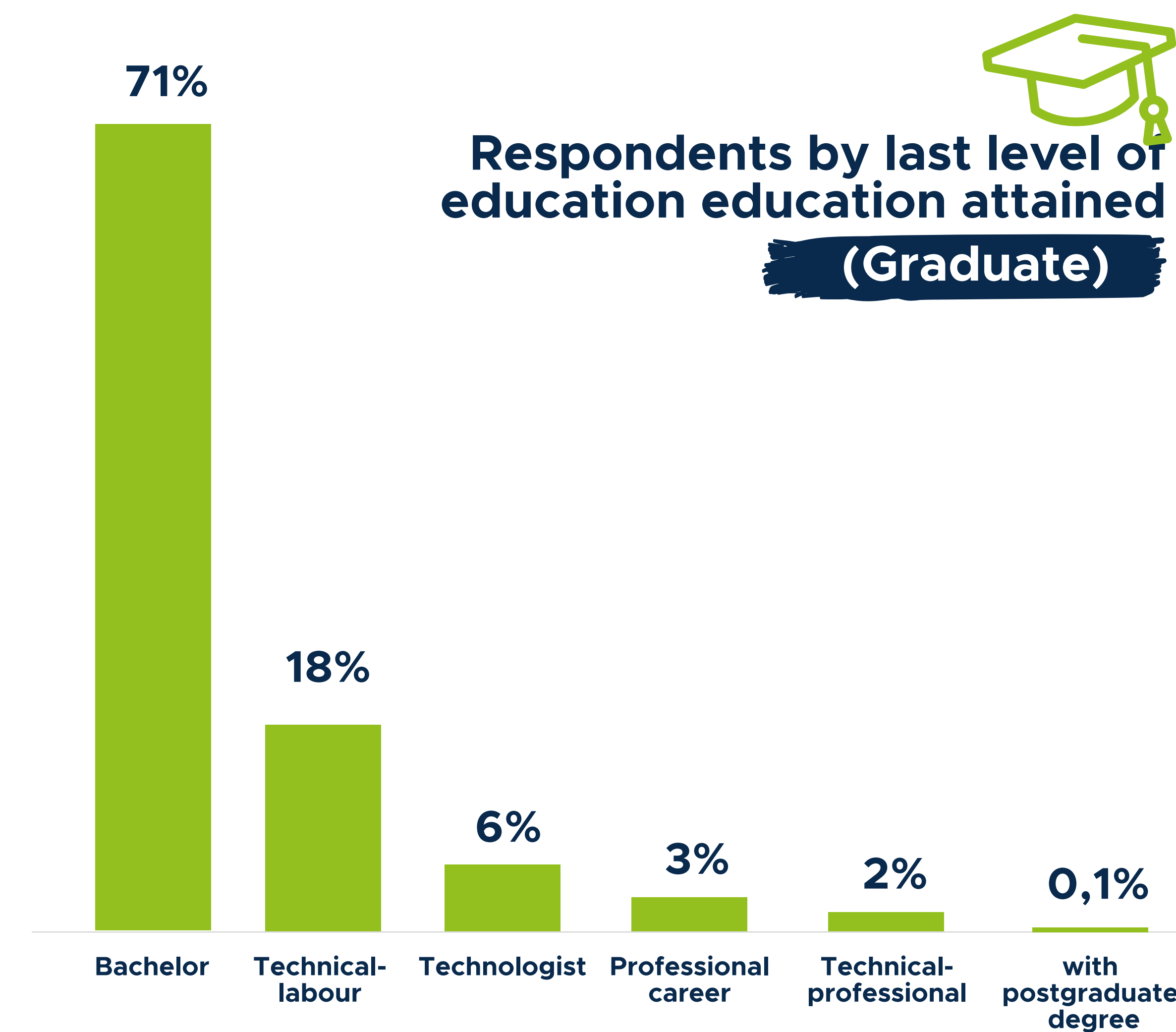
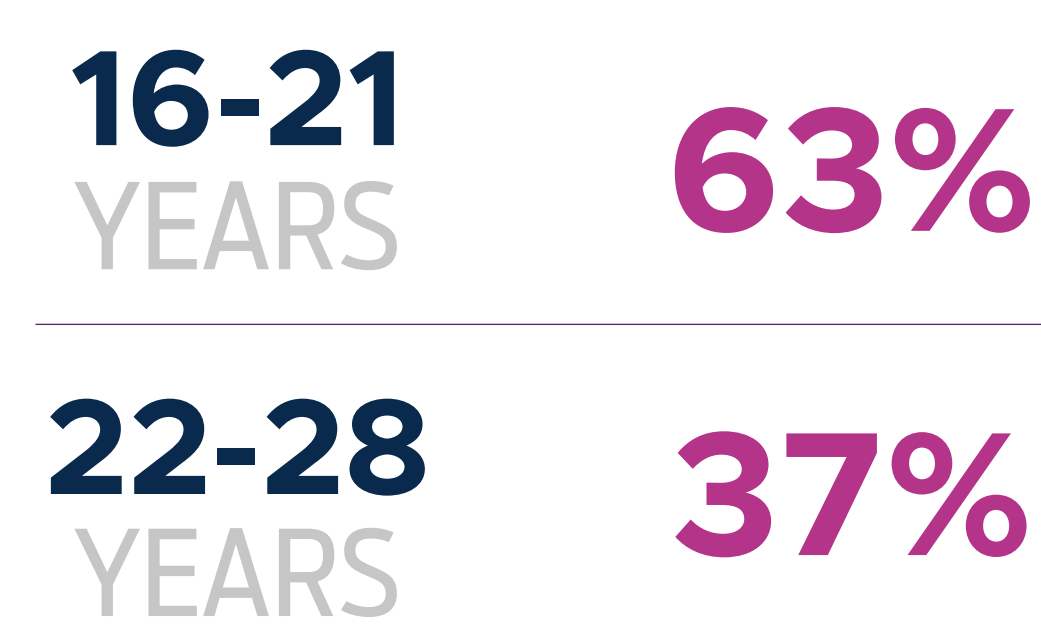
To estimate the proportion of high school graduates between 16 and 28 years old living in the villages of Medellín and attend post-secondary education.

1.506 people participated in this study

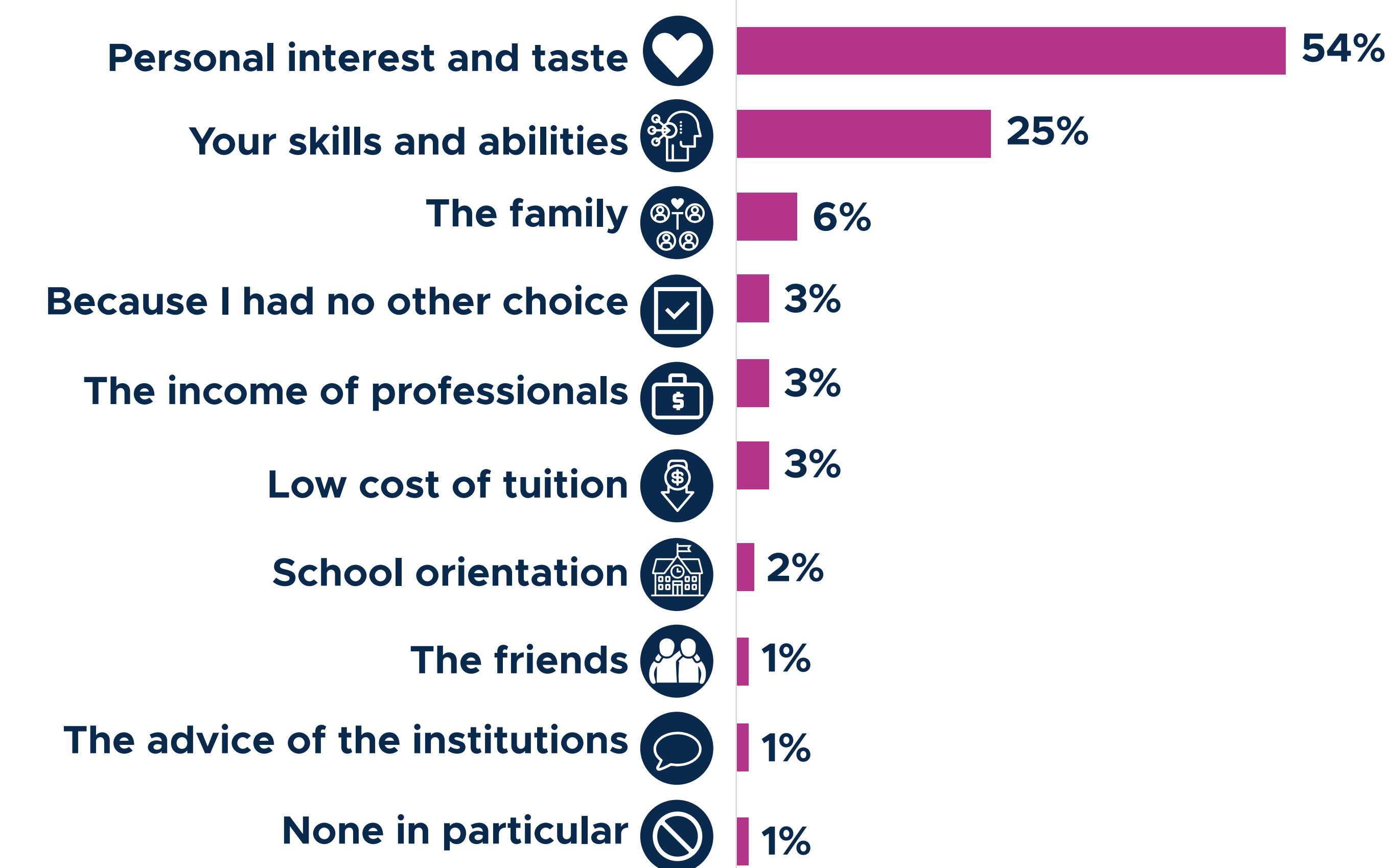
Sex

Reasons for deciding program you are studying



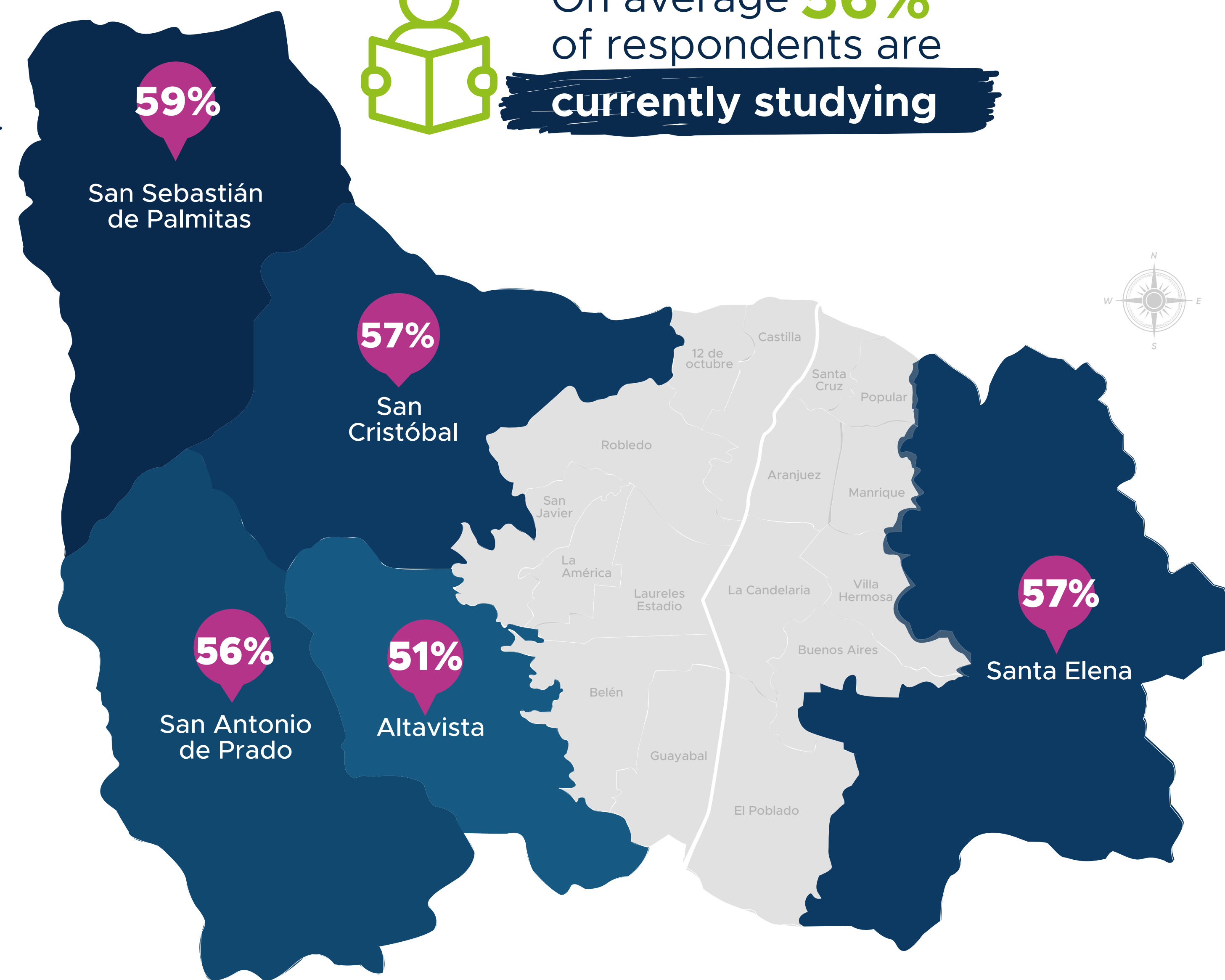

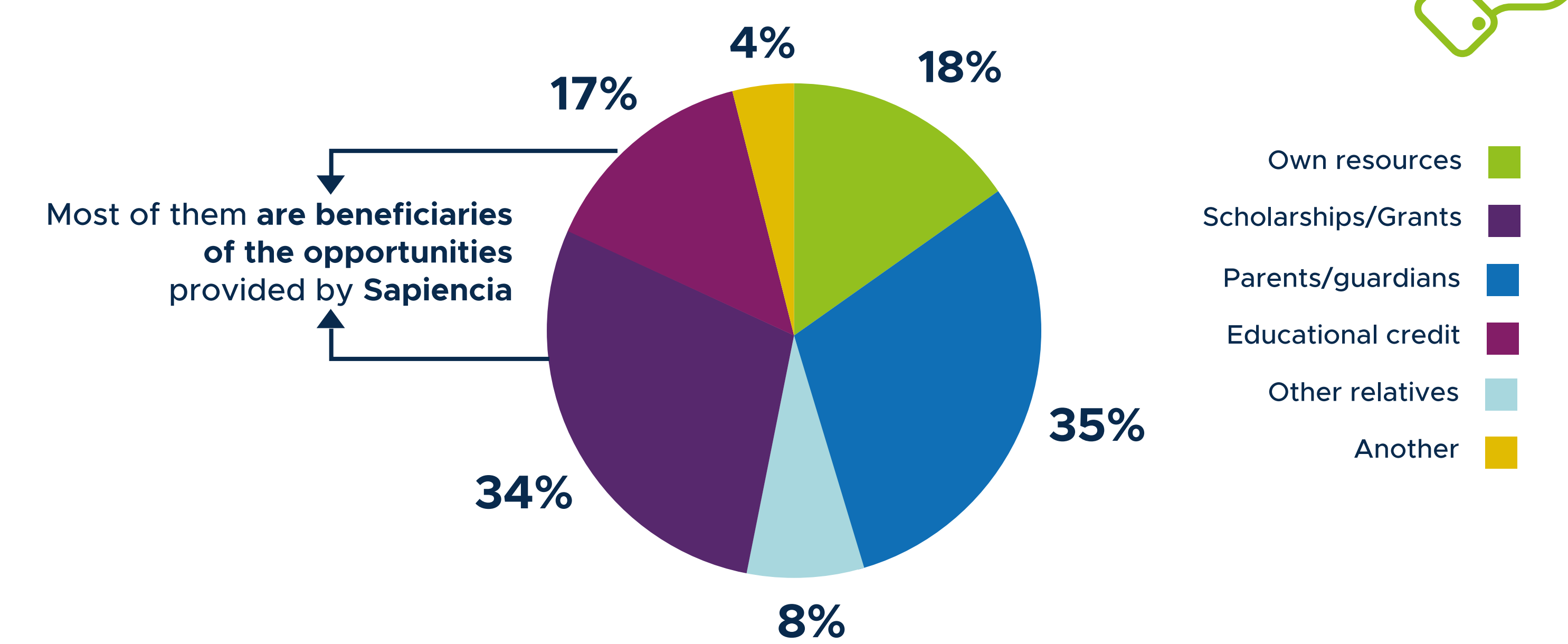
On average **56%** of respondents are currently studying



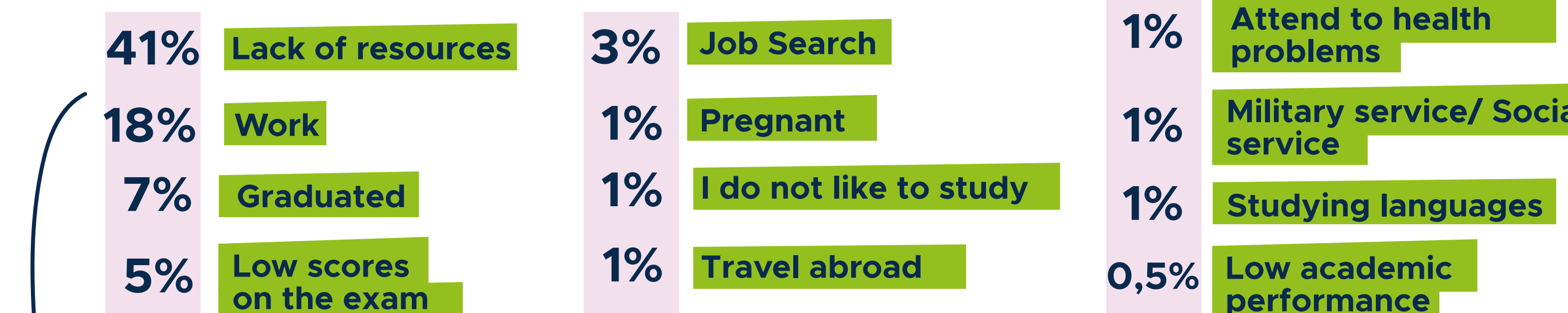
83%
