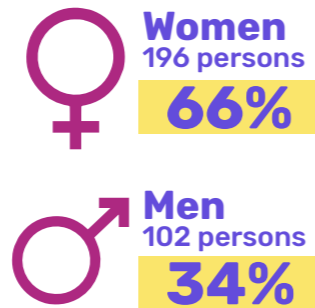

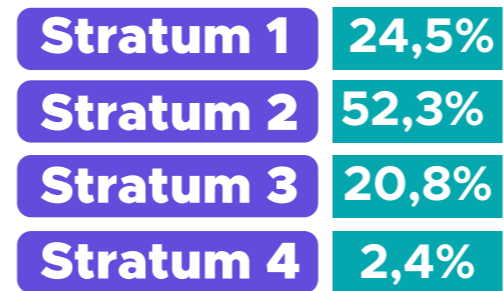

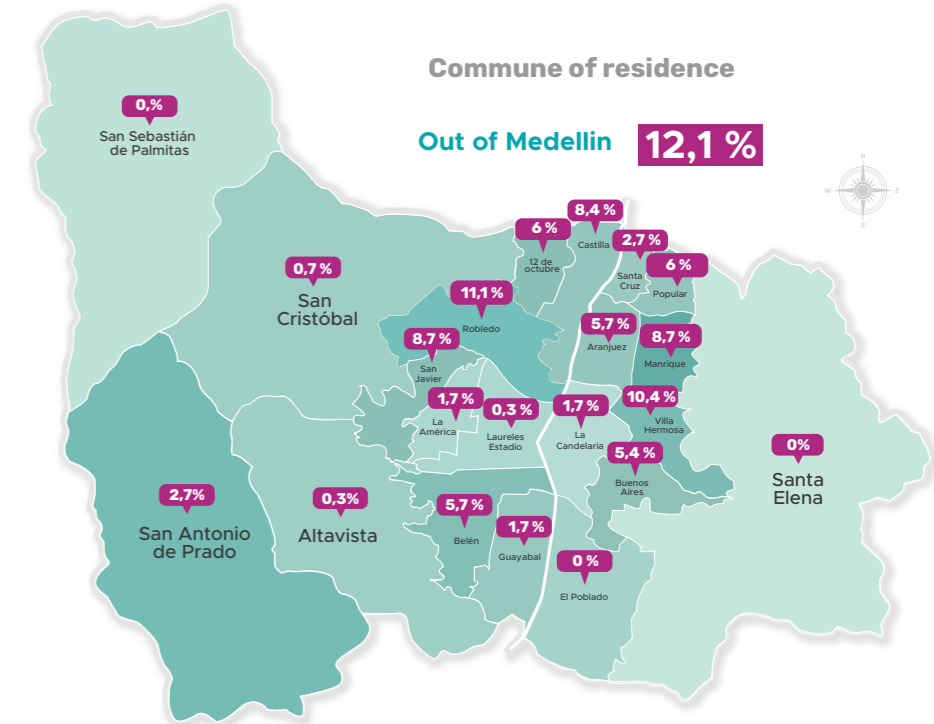
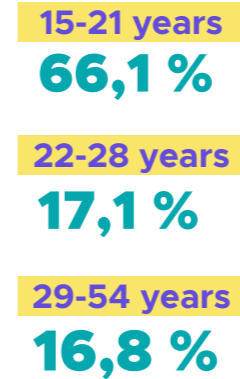
Sex



Stratum

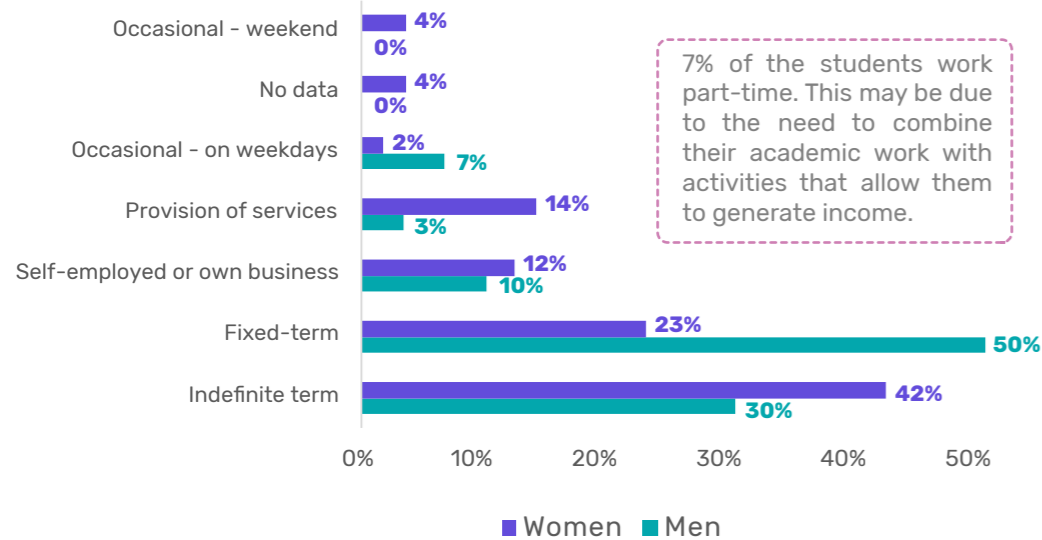


Age range



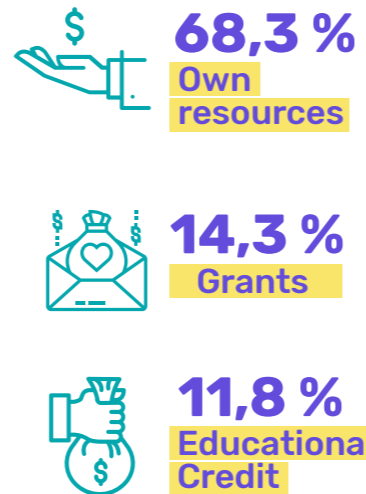

Type of contract and gender



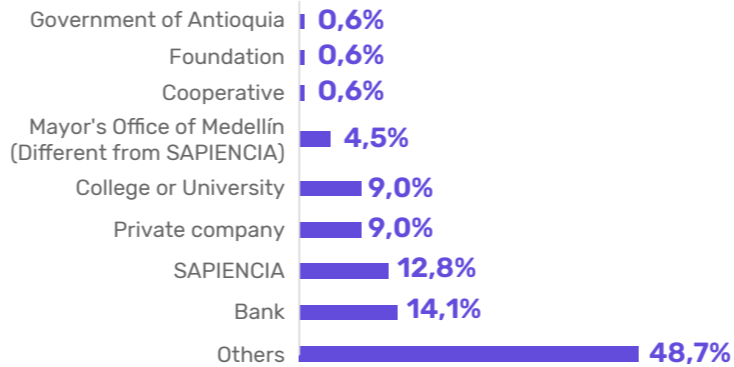
7% of the students work part-time. This may be due to the need to combine their academic work with activities that allow them to generate income.

## Main sources of financing



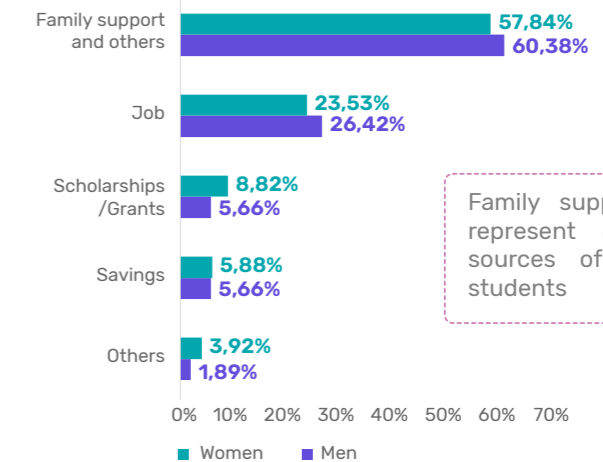
## Those with credit

With public funds from the Mayor's Office of Medellín and from Sapiencia, education is financed for 17.3% of the ETDH students who participated in the survey.

## FINAL REFLECTIONS

The ETDH training provides students the possibility of developing technical competencies in specific areas, which allows them to solve in real contexts, and therefore facilitates their incorporation into socio-occupational scenarios.

Agreement 055 of 2022 defines, among other matters, the provision of scholarships for Education for Work and Human Development (ETDH), thereby creating favorable conditions for access to this educational level from the District. In this way, it contributes to the post-secondary education system of the city.

From Education-Business-State articulation exercises, it is possible to implement actions to strengthen and promote the ETDH in Medellín, as a strategic action to contribute to the configuration of the Science, Technology and Innovation District.
