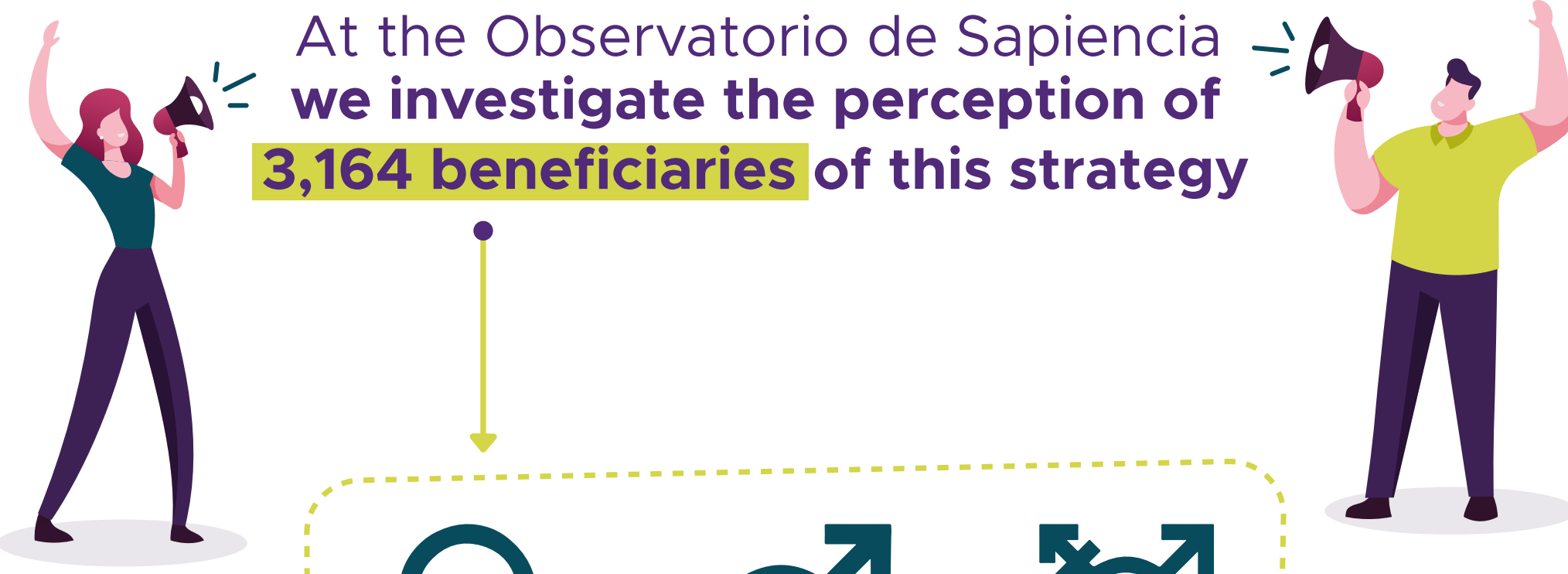
This strategy was implemented in the middle of the Covid-19 pandemic by Medellín mayor's office to ensure the access and the permanence of students in the public HEI of the municipality



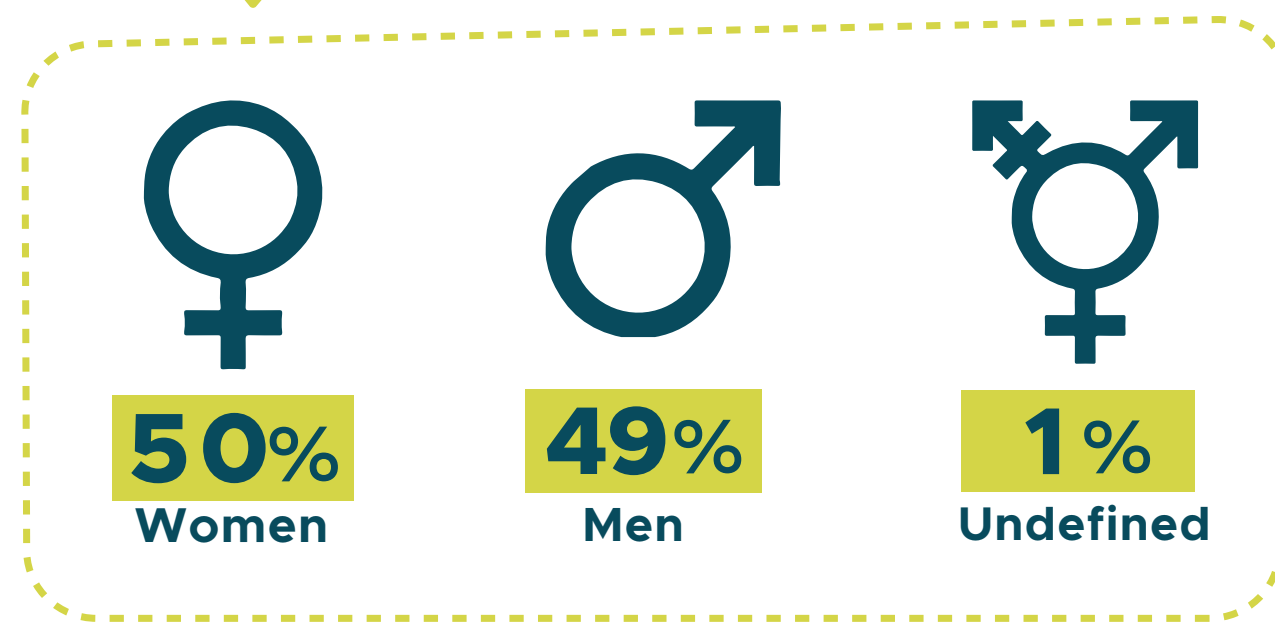

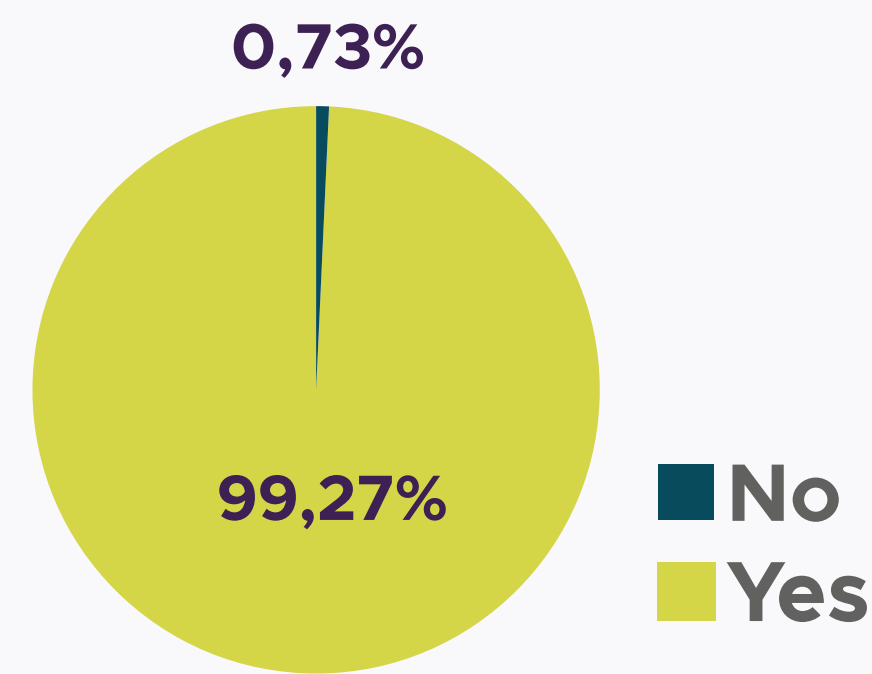


At the Observatorio de Sapiencia we investigate the perception of **3,164 beneficiaries** of this strategy

Do you consider that **Matrícula Cero** has made easier your access to higher education?



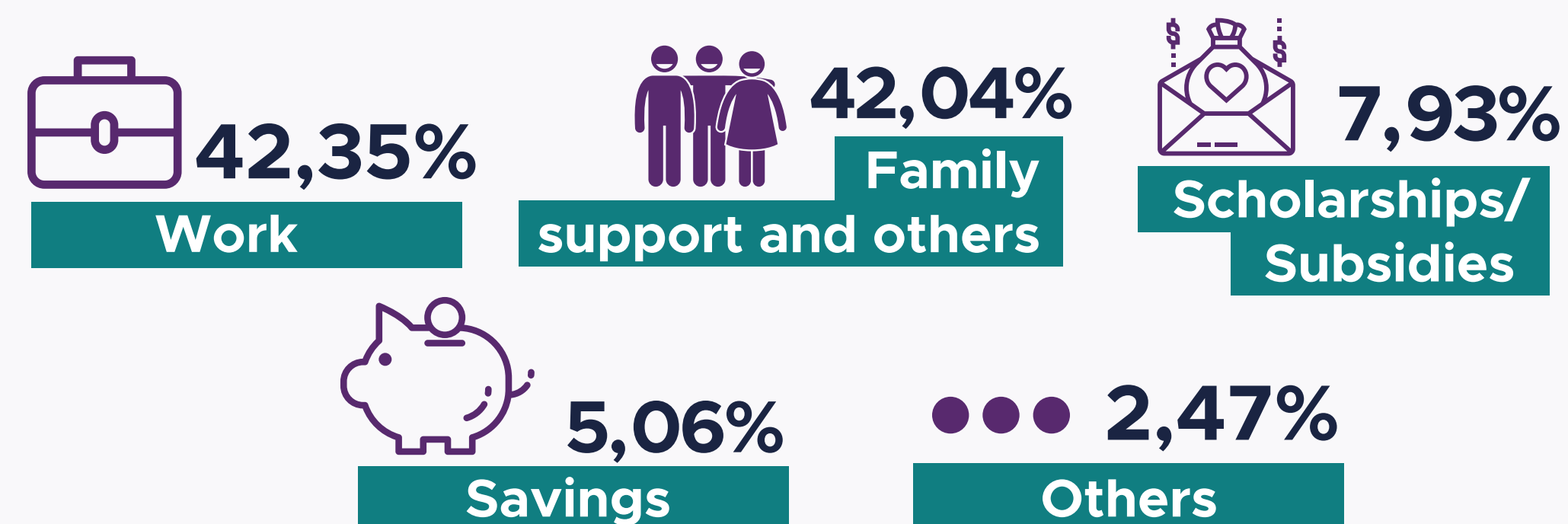
74% of the survey respondents wouldn't be able to keep studying without this strategy



20% of the beneficiaries joined the program to begin their first semester

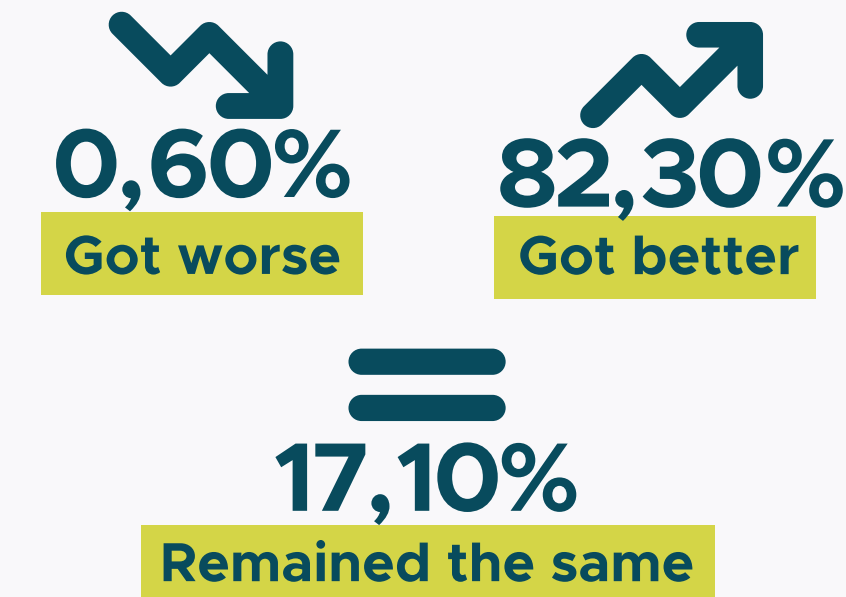
What is the main **source of income** to assume expenses associated with the academic process?

(transportation, food, materials, etc.)

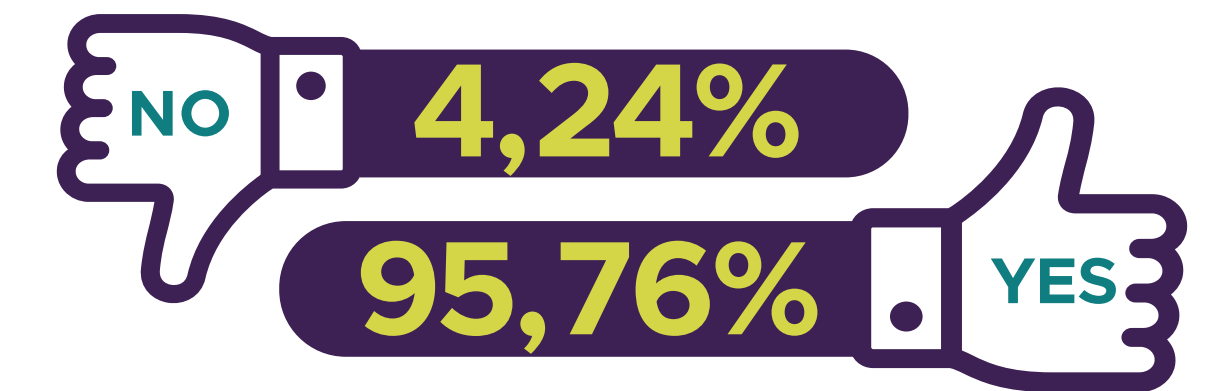


98% of the survey respondents felt challenged to have a better academic performance
